Curriculum

- High quality teaching and a breadth of learning opportunities for all pupils
- Prioritised support from teaching assistants in class
- Staff trained through specific programme, "Achievement for All"
- Being first pupils to benefit from Teacher Help desk and books are marked first
- Chrome books provided to access remote learning and homework
- Lunchtime Homework Club
- First to read with adult helpers
- Reading intervention (Project X code) for struggling readers
- Licenses to Lexia online reading intervention
- Third Space maths intervention (Y5 and 6) targeted, individual lessons weekly
- Numicon intervention in Year 3 and 4
- Curriculum enrichment opportunities (i.e. trips and workshops) heavily subsidised

Extra-curricular

- Structured Conversations with parents in addition to Parent Consultations
- Two bursaries awarded annually to "Rocksteady" rock band lessons
- School uniform jumper and tie provided free if requested
- Free leavers hoodie and year book for Year 6 pupils
- All residential trips are heavily subsidised at the discretion of the Headteacher
- All sports clubs paid for

Pastoral

- All children are met daily at the gate by the Headteacher who builds a strong, supportive relationship with our Pupil Premium pupils
- Activity Club and Lego Club
- Targeted social and emotional support if required to improve interaction with peers and to support self-regulation
- Alternative lunchtime play provision in the Hub if required
- Priority time with ELSA or pastoral support workers
- Pupil Premium pupils are discussed as first agenda item at our weekly Staff Meetings
